Motorists are advised that traffic lanes will be shifted on South Gilmore Road and Holden Boulevard on Friday night, August 26, 2016, weather permitting. Parkland Hills Drive will be closed at South Gilmore Road as part of this traffic shift. The closure and lane configuration are expected to last approximately 4 weeks.

This is for the continued work on the intersection project at Route 4 / Holden Boulevard / South Gilmore Road being performed by the John R. Jurgensen Company, under contract for the City of Fairfield. This project consists of the addition of a second southbound lane on Holden Boulevard and South Gilmore Road, the realignment of the road across Route 4, and a new mast arm signal.

During the closure of Parkland Hills Drive, a detour will be posted routing traffic around the construction site via Route 4 to Boehm Drive.
