Local wake boarding park opens for season

FAIRFIELD — A cable wake boarding complex in Butler County opens today for the season.

Wake Nation Cincinnati in Joyce Park on the Hamilton and Fairfield city borders offers wake boarding, water skiing, knee boarding and wake skating. The lake is 10 acres, officials said.

"Riders are pulled around the oval lake at speeds of 18-20 miles per hour by a circulating, overhead cable system that runs 35 feet above the water," officials said in a release.

The park is open noon to 8 p.m. Wednesdays through Sundays through the spring. Summer hours begin June 1, the release states.
