## **Phase two of annual fire hydrant flushing is Thursday**

**Fairfield, OH** - The second phase of the City of Fairfield's annual fire hydrant flushing program will be Thursday, April 6, 2017, at 4 p.m., and may last four to six hours.

Residents may experience discolored water for a short period of time. Allowing faucets to run for five to 10 minutes should clear the water if it is used while a flushing crew is in the area.

The affected areas include east of Pleasant Avenue to Route 4 and Hicks Boulevard and east of Pleasant Avenue to Fairfield Avenue and Nilles Road. All of the Rolling Hills Subdivision will be affected, including Evalie, Red Oak and Tolleywood to Hunter Road. In addition, the area east of Pleasant Avenue, west to Winton Road, and south to Resor Road as well as Robert E. Lee and Stonewall Lanes will be affected.

Other areas included are the northern corporation boundary south to Mack Road and east to Winton Road and the area west of Winton Road from Hicks Boulevard to Resor Road.
