## **Mack water tower drained, covered for painting** *Project expected to be complete in October*

**Fairfield, OH** - Fairfield's Public Utilities Department and its contractor Horizon Brothers are in the process of painting the Mack Road water tower both inside and out. The tower has been drained and is now covered by canvas to prevent debris and paint from spreading as work occurs.

This project started in August and is expected to last into October. It is part of the City's ongoing capital improvement program aimed at maintaining and preserving critical city assets.

Because the tank had to be drained to do the work and it needs to be back in service as quickly as possible, the contractor has been authorized to work seven days a week, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Also, during all sandblasting activities, a special product to bind up and safely contain heavy metals will be used.
