LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 22-2014

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on December 8, 2014. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 108-14            Community Reinvestment Area Agreement and a Community Reinvestment Area Compensation Agreement which will provide property tax incentives for Element Materials Technology, Inc. and Morel Ventures, LLC for the renovation and expansion of an office and warehouse facility at 3701 Port Union Road and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 109-14            Ordinance to make estimated appropriations for the expenses and other expenditures of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, during the period beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2015.
- Ord. 110-14            Ordinance to reconcile accounts.
- Ord. 111-14            Issuance of \$21,408.60 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to pay part of the cost of sidewalk repair in the city and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 112-14            Issuance of \$18,332.67 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to pay part of the cost of sidewalk repair in the city and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 113-14            Issuance of \$17,283.08 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to pay part of the cost of sidewalk repair in the city and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 114-14            Issuance of \$36,218.25 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to pay part of the cost of sidewalk repair in the city and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 115-14            Issuance of \$93,242.60 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to pay part of the cost of sidewalk repair in the city and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 116-14            Non-Contractual Appropriations - \$32,315.80 for Ross Road Emergency Water System repairs
