

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 11-2017

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on June 12, 2017. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 60-17 Five (5) year contract with Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. for the collection of solid waste and recycling services for all residential units in the City of Fairfield.

- Ord. 61-17 Amend subsection 953.01(a) of Ordinance No. 166-84, the Codified Ordinances of Fairfield, Ohio relative to the service fee for residential garbage and solid waste collection and recycling charged by the City to City residents.

- Ord. 62-17 Amendment to the existing agreement with Dynegy Energy Services East, LLC (Dynegy) for the continued supply of electric retail power for all municipal facilities and lights and to extend the agreement for thirty-six (36) months through December 2020 and declaring an emergency.

- Ord. 63-17 Three (3) year contract with Synagro Central, LLC for the disposal of wastewater biosolids.

- Ord. 64-17 Contract with Mohon Blastings & Coatings, LLC for the City's Re-paint Existing Water Treatment Plant Clarifier No. 1 Project.

- Ord. 65-17 Application for financial assistance and enter into an agreement for a grant to fund a portion of the Interstate 275-Exit 39 (South Gilmore and Ramp Y) Improvements Project and declaring an emergency.

- Ord. 66-17 Contract with WG Stang LLC for the 2017 Seward Road Culvert Extension Project and declaring an emergency.

- Ord. 67-17 Contract with Henderson Products, Inc. for the outfitting of a single axle dump truck for Public Works Department and declaring an emergency.

- Ord. 68-17 Appropriation Ordinance (Contractual Items) – \$155,910 re-coat of Clarifier #1; \$200,000 Seward Road Culvert Extension; \$79,740 outfitting of dump truck.

- Ord. 69-17 Appropriation Ordinance (Non-Contractual Items) – \$14,850 inspection services for Clarifier #1; \$20,000 purchase of software; \$14,632 purchase and installation of new boiler tubes for Wastewater; \$3,300 for consultant agreement for Rt. 4 overhead signs on mast arm supports; \$10,000 for traffic signal system assistance; \$15,000 for miscellaneous traffic signal upgrades/spare parts; \$30,000 2017 Pleasant and Patterson Intersection improvements; \$25,993 purchase of Hunter GSP9700 wheel balancer for garage and replacement oil pumps (various vendors); \$24,200 outfitting of Ford F-350 for Water Division; \$35,000 for Ross Road wall replacement; \$20,000 for purchase of hydrants; \$16,275 for replacement of computer workstations.
