

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 9-2017

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on May 8, 2017. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Res. 5-17 Adoption of post-issuance compliance policies for tax-exempt obligations and continuing disclosure obligations and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 44-17 Contract with Adleta Construction for the Vinnedge Avenue Vicinity Improvements Project.
- Ord. 45-17 Three (3) year contract with Rozzi, Inc. for the production of the annual Red, White and Kaboom event and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 46-17 Contract with Charles D. Baumann, Sr. for the purchase of the Baumann property at 6090 Gray Road, Fairfield, Ohio.
- Ord. 47-17 Contract with Lake Erie Electric, Inc. for the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical Improvements Project.
- Ord. 48-17 Contract with JW Brennan Excavating, LLC for the Ross Road Relief Sewer Project.
- Ord. 49-17 Agreement with the City of Hamilton, Ohio for cooperatively funding improvements to River Road between St. Clair Avenue and Fairview Avenue and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 50-17 Contract with Contract Sweepers & Equipment for the purchase of a Tymco Street Sweeper for Public Works Department.
- Ord. 51-17 Contract with Fuller Ford for the purchase of vehicles for use in the Parks, Utilities (Water Division), Police, Court and Public Works Departments and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 52-17 2017 Wage & Salary Ordinance
- Ord. 53-17 Appropriation Ordinance (Contractual Items) – \$411,000 for purchase of Baumann property; \$1,568,420 for Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical Improvements Project; \$240,000 for Ross Road Relief Sewer Project; \$100,000 for River Road improvements; \$167,210 for purchase of Tymco Street Sweeper; \$192,100 for purchase of vehicles.
- Ord. 54-17 Appropriation Ordinance (Non-Contractual Items) – \$15,000 for Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical Improvements Project; \$48,000 for outfitting of vehicles; \$6,000 for purchase of trailer for Parks Department; \$51,000 for purchase of Personal Protective Equipment (various vendors); \$30,000 for purchase of Automatic External Defibrillators (AED's); \$20,000 for Lane Library Repair and Upgrades; \$12,000 for Parks Facility Upgrades; \$7,755 for Seward Road Pedestrian Crossing; \$17,750 for Safety Study; \$16,800 for bridge maintenance improvements; \$10,000 for geotechnical and testing services; \$15,000 for engineering support services related to Kay Drive Pressure-Reducing Valve (PRV) installation; \$16,000 for replacement of existing Relief Sewer Overflow Structure Sluice Gates in Wastewater Division; \$18,536 for purchase of chemicals to remove roots from public sewer mains; \$12,000 for purchase of replacement pumps for Fairfield Village Sanitary Pump Station; \$32,000 for repair/replacement of cart paths at Fairfield Greens Golf Course facilities.
