

CITY OF FAIRFIELD  
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 17-2013

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on October 15, 2013. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 83-13 FY 2013 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application and agreement and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 84-13 Change order to the contract with Smithcorp, Inc. for additional water line repairs and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 85-13 Contract with LJB, Inc. for detailed engineering tasks for the Route 4 & Holden Improvement Project and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 86-13 Declare one (1) city vehicle and a lawn mower as surplus and authorize the City Manager to sell the vehicle and lawn mower on GovDeals.com.
- Ord. 87-13 Ordinance to reconcile accounts.
- Ord. 88-13 Ordinance to establish salaries and hourly rates for certain salaried and hourly employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio and to authorize and limit the numbers and types of certain employees, to repeal Ordinance No. 31-13 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 89-13 Appropriation Ordinance (Contractual Items) - \$27,500 for Smithcorp, Inc. contract change order for water main improvements at Winton and Mack Road; \$204,353 for contract with LJB, Inc. for detailed engineering for Route 4 & Holden Improvement Project.
- Ord. 90-13 Appropriation Ordinance (Non-Contractual Items) - \$7,355 for additional security improvements for Public Works, Fire Department, and Public Utilities Department; \$14,500 for purchase of a 2013 Toro Z Master 6000 mower and snow blower attachment for Street Division; \$10,200 for Water Plant roof replacement; \$2,857 for purchase of a Cisco Ethernet Switch for security system at Public Utilities Campus.
- Res. 13-13 Resolution in support of Issue #8, The Fairfield City School Bond Issue, on the November 5, 2013 ballot.
