

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 15-2016

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on September 12, 2016. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 76-16 Agreement for indigent legal representation for 2017 in the Fairfield Municipal Court with the Butler County Public Defender Commission/Butler County Board of Commissioners and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 77-16 Execute an Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Issue 1 Grant Application and Project Agreement for the North Gilmore Road Improvements Project and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 78-16 Contract with CT Consultants for the engineering services for Fairfield's city-wide traffic signal system and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 79-16 Declare three (3) city motor vehicles and two (2) pieces of city equipment as surplus and authorize the City Manager to sell the motor vehicles and equipment on GovDeals.com.
- Ord. 80-16 Contract with Trane, Cincinnati, Ohio for the purchase of a chiller for the Community Arts Center and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 81-16 Establish salaries and hourly rates for certain salaried and hourly employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio and to authorize and limit the numbers and types of certain employees, to repeal Ordinance No. 50-16 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 82-16 Appropriation Ordinance (Contractual Appropriations) – \$167,884 for city-wide traffic signal system; \$70,000 reimbursement of public water main; \$110, 108 Community Arts Center Chiller Replacement.
- Ord. 83-16 Appropriation Ordinance (Non-Contractual Appropriations) – \$28,000 for emergency repair and re-installation of High Service Pump #4 and Filter Backwash Pump at Water Treatment Plant; \$7,500 for purchase of variable frequency drive for high service pump/motor assembly at Water Treatment Plant; \$42,400 for design, engineering and bidding/bidding preparation support services for construction of Ross Road Sanitary Relief Sewer System; \$4,950 for upgrades at Community Arts Center; \$9,208 for purchase of eight (8) tasers, holsters, cartridges and batteries for Municipal Court; \$6,155 for purchase of Ricoh MP4054SP copier for Municipal Court.
- Res. 9-16 Accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Butler County Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor.
