LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 11-2009

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on June 8, 2009. - Ord. 82-09 Contract with Capital Electric Line Builders, Inc. for the 2009 Traffic Signal Power Backup Upgrade Project.
- Ord. 83-09 Contract with ME Companies for the design of the Resor Road Improvement Project.
- Ord. 84-09 Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 166-84, the Codified Ordinances of Fairfield, Ohio, Section 1141.02, the City of Fairfield, Ohio, Zoning Map.
- Ord. 85-09 Ordinance approving the Fairfield Township and City Joint Economic District I Contract.
- Ord. 86-09 Agreement with Dr. Steven Yamaguchi, M.D., FACP for services as the Medical Director for the Fairfield Fire Department.
- Ord. 87-09 Contract with Lake Erie Construction Company for the 2009 Guardrail Improvement Project.
- Ord. 88-09 Contract with C.A. Stempfley for the Tri-County Assembly of God Driveway Project.
- Ord. 89-09 Authorization to enter into an annexation agreement as part of the JEDD with Fairfield Township.
- Ord. 90-09 Agreement with Clemmons & Wolterman Law Firm, LLC for legal services.
- Ord. 91-09 Authorization to enter into a tax-exempt lease/purchase agreement with Key Government Finance, Inc. for equipment related to the City's new voicemail system.
- Ord. 92-09 2009 Budget Amendment: \$35,000 for guardrail improvements and \$30,000 for Tri-County Assembly of God Driveway Access.
- Ord. 93-09 2009 Budget Amendments: \$14,455 for equipment for emergency operations center; \$12,983 for replacement traffic reconstruction equipment; \$22,315 for Information Technology upgrades to Municipal Building; \$4,984 for traffic signals at Dixie/Camelot; and \$23,540 for Justice Center irrigation system.
- Ord. 94-09 2009 Budget Amendment: \$50,000 for charitable donation passed onto Fairfield Community Foundation per donors request.
