

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 5-2012

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on March 12, 2012. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Res. 4-12 Resolution to authorize and ratify the Public Works Department's provision of assistance of manpower and equipment to assist in the storm/tornado cleanup of Moscow, Ohio.
- Ord. 16-12 Contract with America's Decorative Concrete for 2012 concrete repair and replacement work.
- Ord. 17-12 Contract with Brad Evans Excavating for 2012 Sidewalk/Apron Replacement Program.
- Ord. 18-12 Ordinance to amend Chapter 733, entitled "Secondhand Dealers", of Ordinance No. 166-84, the Codified Ordinances of Fairfield, Ohio.
- Ord. 19-12 Contract with Rozzi's Famous Fireworks, Inc. for annual Red, White and Kaboom event.
- Ord. 20-12 Three year Contract with Contract Sweepers & Equipment for street sweeping services.
- Ord. 21-12 Three year Contract with Capital Electric Line Builders, Wagner Smith Division, for traffic signal maintenance services.
- Ord. 22-12 Ordinance providing for issuance of not to exceed \$3,300,000 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, for the purpose of refunding Various Purpose Bonds in the City and authorizing an official statement.
- Ord. 23-12 Ordinance providing for the issuance of not to exceed \$5,015,000 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, for the purpose of refunding Community Center Bonds in the City, authorizing an official statement, and authorizing an escrow deposit agreement.
- Ord. 24-12 Ordinance providing for the issuance of not to exceed \$8,315,000 of bonds by the City of Fairfield, Ohio, for refunding outstanding Various Purpose Bonds and Community Center Bonds; authorizing an official statement and authorizing an escrow deposit agreement.
- Ord. 25-12 2012 Budget Amendments: \$20,000 asbestos abatement work with Pleasant Run Flood Control Program; \$24,562 By-Pass 4 Widening Project Bridge Painting Inspection.
