



# Fairfield Police Department UCR Part I Crime Statistics Snapshot Report...Period Ending 10/31/13

Table 1 shows the number of UCR Part I offenses reported to the Fairfield Police Department beginning in the year 2007. The data from 2007-2011 suggested a downward trend in reported crime. In 2012, there was an increase in reported crime but it is unknown at this time if this increase represents a trend reversal.




## Violent & Property Crimes

UCR classifies homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault as violent crimes. Burglary, theft, auto theft, and arson are classified as property crimes. For 2013, 90% of the reported Part I crimes to the Fairfield Police were property crimes. Using the latest published UCR data from 2012, Chart 1 and Chart 2 compare the violent and property crime rates in Fairfield to the overall rates in Ohio<sup>2</sup> and to the rates in the cities of Hamilton and Middletown<sup>3</sup>. 



