Annual yard debris pickup starting Monday, April 3

Fairfield, OH - Beginning Monday, April 3, 2017, the Public Works Department will again provide the call-in Brush and Limb Pickup Program for residents. This program will last through October.

To participate or to ask questions, residents should call or email the Public Works Department at 867-4200, public_works@fairfield-city.org. A week advance notice for pickup requests would be helpful though requests will generally be accepted up until the Friday before the scheduled Monday pickup. Please leave your name, address, and phone number in a voice mail or email.

The schedule is the same as the fall leaf pickup program:

- The **first** week of each month – areas west of Pleasant Avenue (U.S. 127)
- The **second** week of each month – areas between Pleasant Avenue and Winton Road
- The **third** week of each month – areas east of Winton Road

For larger limbs and brush loads, another program called “Operation Dump Truck” is provided by the City for residents. A dumpster box or dump truck to be loaded by property owners and disposed of by the City will be brought to your home.
